

## Unit 1 – Lesson 1, pages 1-2 - Glossary **II**

- gulf [n] = a place where the sea comes into the land, e.g. *Thermaikos gulf*, [κόλπος]
- hometown [n] = home + town = the town where my home is, e.g. *I live in London now, but my hometown is Brighton*, [γενέτειρα]
- earthquake [n] = when the earth shakes, e.g. *There was a big earthquake in Turkey and many buildings were destroyed*, [σεισμός]
- beauty [n] → beautiful [adj]
- mountain [n] → mountainous [adj]
- sun [n] → sunny [adj]
- win [vb] → winner [n]
- heavy [adj] → heavily [adv]
- capital city = the biggest city in a country, e.g. *London is Britain's capital*, [πρωτεύουσα]
- coast [n] = the point where the land meets the sea, [ακτή]
- flow [vb] = how water or air move, e.g. *River Dnipro flows across Ukraine*, [κυλάω]

- split [vb] = separate, break into pieces, cut, e.g. *He split the chocolate and gave me half*, [χωρίζω, μοιράζω]
- outdoors [adv] = outside, in the open air, [έξω, στη φύση]
- outgoing [adj] = friendly people who like going out, [φιλικός, κοινωνικός]
- share borders with/border with = when two countries are right next to each other, e.g. *Greece shares borders with Turkey*, [συνορεύω]
- drop [vb] = fall or let sth fall, e.g. *She dropped her keys and couldn't find them*, [ρίχνω/πέφτω]
- natural disasters → earthquakes, tsunamis, volcanos, tornadoes, hurricanes, [φυσικές καταστροφές]
- mild [adj] = not very strong or extreme, e.g. *This coffee has a mild taste*, [μέτριος, όχι πολύ έντονος]
