- invention VS discovery
invention is making sth new, something that never existed before [εφεύρεση]
discovery is finding sth that existed but we didn't know about it [ανακάλυψη]
- invent [vb] → invention [n] → inventor [n] = the person who makes an invention [εφευρέτης]
- biography [n] = (bios = life + graphi = writing) the story of sbd's life [βιογραφία]
- an incident [n] = an event, sth that happens [περιστατικό]
- imprison [vb] = put sbd in prison so that they can't escape [φυλακίζω]
- beast [n] = an animal or monster [κτῆνος]
- feathers [n] = the soft covering of a bird's body [πούπουλα]
- wax [n] = material made by bees, what candles are made of [κερί]
- simulator [n] = a machine that makes you believe you are in a specific environment, e.g. a *flight simulator* [προσομοιωτής]
- fly [vb] → flight [n] → flyer or flier [n]
- admire [vb] = like and respect sth or sbd very much [θαυμάζω]
- repair [vb] = fix sth broken [επισκευάζω]
- last [vb] = take a specific amount of time [διαρκώ]
- melt [vb] = λιώνω
